## Home School Agreement

The School will work to:

The Family will try to:

- Make sure their child arrives at school on time (doors open 8:50am) and attends regularly.
- Ensure that the school is notified directly/by telephone, as soon as possible, when their child is absent
- Ensure that requests to authorise holidays in term time are made only in very exceptional circumstances
- Take an active part in their child's progress by supporting school events where possible, attending parents' evenings and maintaining regular contact with the school.
- Support the school's policies, including those relating to behaviour and homework, helping their child as best as they are able.
- Talk to the class teacher or headteacher if there are any problems of which the school should be aware.
